COMMISSION**


SASSETA is committed to conduct its business ethically with honesty and integrity. The SETA aims to positively influence skills development in the safety and security sector through positive, transparent and eligible conduct with its Stakeholders. For this reason, SASSETA was permitted by the Public Service Commission (PSC) to make use of the National Anti-Corruption hotline for whistle blowing services.

We therefore urge our Stakeholders to report any suspected fraud, unlawful acts and misconduct that is observed or came to your attention. The Anti-corruption hotline will be managed by the PSC, which is mandated by *Sections 195 and Section 196 of the Constitution, 1996*. The PSC is tasked and empowered to, amongst other, investigate, monitor and evaluate the organization and administration of the public service. It is also enlisted as one of the institutions protected under the Protected Disclosure Act to ensure that the identity of people who report suspected corruption and unlawful conduct in good faith are protected by the Protected Disclosure Act. The whistle blower's identity will never be revealed therefore no one will ever know who made the report.

SASSETA Stakeholders are thus encouraged to utilize the whistle blowing services through the PSC's anti-corruption hotline on **0800 701 701**, which is available during 08h00 - 16h30 working hours and a recording facility after these hours. The reports can be made in any of the eleven South African official languages.
