



CALL FOR RE-NOMINATION OF PERSONS TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF SASSETA

The Safety and Security Sector Education and Training Authority (SASSETA), on behalf of the Minister of Higher Education and Training, Dr BE Nzimande invites applications for suitably qualified persons to serve as employer and employee representatives of the SASSETA Board. The new Board will serve from 01 April 2018 until 31 March 2020.

This is a re-nomination process following a Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET) consultative process with employer and employee stakeholders and the subsequent decision taken by the Director General to extend the administration period up until 31 March 2018. (Ref: Government Notice No.626 published in the Government Gazette 41033 of 8 August 2017).

Nominated representatives from organised labour, organised employers as well as recognised professional bodies representing employer and employees are invited to nominate persons who could represent them on the Board of SASSETA. Nominee should possess knowledge, skills and competencies in the following disciplines:

- Application of corporate governance and ethics,
- Skills development legislation and the NSDSIII,
- The Public Management Finance Act,
- Financial management,
- Education, training, skills development and human resources development,
- Quality assurance of learning provision, and
- Security sector knowledge and participation.

In addition, Government departments (who are not employers), Non-Governmental Organisations (NGO), Community-Based Organisations (CBO), interested Professional Bodies or critical interest groups are invited to nominate persons who will make up the two additional representatives on the Board. These nominations should be clearly marked 'Nominations for Additional Board Appointments'.

Organisations, employers and unions who submitted their nominees during the initial Board nomination process should re-submit their nominations.

The criteria for nomination, nomination forms and details for nominations as well as the SASSETA Constitution, are available on the SASSETA website www.sasseta.org.za. Correspondence will be limited to short-listed candidates only.

The closing date for nominations is Tuesday, 26 September 2017 at 16:00.
