The Safety and Security Sector Education and Training Authority (SASSETA) invites member employers, public training institutes including public TVET colleges, NGO's, CBO's and trade unions operating in the safety and security sector as well as unemployed youth studying at public institutions towards the scarce and critical skills in the Safety and Security Sector to submit applications for Discretionary Grants for the 1st funding window for 2019/2020 financial year. Private sector employers must be registered under SASSETA, paying levies to SASSETA or exempt from levies and must have submitted their Workplace Skills Plan/ Pivotal Training Plan to SASSETA.
