## **STAKEHOLDER UPDATE ON THE WORK OF THE COMMISSION**

Dear Stakeholder

The Presidential Remuneration Review Commission (the Commission) was appointed by the President of the Republic of South Africa under section 84(2)(f) of the Constitution on 7 August 2013, pursuant to Proclamation R 33 of 2013 dated 7 August 2013, published in Government Gazette 36757, to enquire into the remuneration and conditions of service in the public service and public entities listed in Parts A and C of Schedule 3 of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999, with remuneration of Educator being given priority.

Initially, the Commission was given eight months to complete its work. However, due to the amount of work and the number of stakeholders involved, the term of the Commission was extended to 6 April 2017 with further six months to prepare and submit a report to the President. These extensions were granted by the President upon the request by the Commission.

The Commission would like to confirm that your submission is receiving attention and further take this opportunity to update you on the progress made thus far regarding its inquiry.


The Commission's scope of the Inquiry consists of five main phases. Whilst the first phase focused on setting up structures, the second phase was devoted to information gathering, (i.e) receiving submissions from Stakeholders such as yourself. The Commission is now at the third phase, which is mainly dealing with verification, clarification and analysis of issues raised from various submissions by stakeholders. The Commission has enlisted the services of experts to do the analysis and identify specific issues that must be addressed by it in its findings and

recommendations to the President.

The fourth and the last phases involve the writing and the issuing of a provisional and final report on the key issues referred to in its Terms of Reference.

The Commission will keep you updated on progress going forward.
