1.5 LATE BIDS

1.5.1 Bids received late shall not be considered. A bid will be considered late if it arrived only one second after 11h00 or any time thereafter. Bids arriving late will not be considered under any circumstances. Bidders are therefore strongly advised to ensure that bids be sent allowing enough time for any unforeseen events that may delay the delivery of the bid.

1.6 FORMAT OF BIDS

- 1.6.1 Bidders to complete all the necessary bid documents and undertakings required in this bid document. Bidders are advised that their bid should be concise, written in plain English.
- 1.6.2 Bidders are to set out their bid in the following format:

Joint Ventures and Consortia are to submit their agreements in order to be evaluated as such.

The value of this bid is estimated <u>not to exceed</u> R50 000 000 (all applicable taxes included) and therefore the 80/20 system shall be applicable.

Where the contract requires the successful bidder to travel to a venue different from SASSETA, the following travel and disbursement processes will be undertaken:

- Claim travel mileage costs applicable to this contract as per the Department of Transport rates

1.8 REASONS FOR REJECTION

- 1.8.1 SASSETA shall reject a bid for the award of a contract if the recommended bidder has committed a proven corrupt or fraudulent act in competing for the particular contract.
- 1.8.2 SASSETA shall disregard the bid of any bidder if that bidder, or any of itsdirectors:
 - 1.8.2.1 have abused the Supply Chain Management systems of SASSETA.
 - 1.8.2.2 have committed proven fraud or any other improper conduct in relation to such systems.
 - 1.8.2.3 have failed to perform on any previous contract and the proof exists.
 - 1.8.2.4 Such actions shall be communicated to the National Treasury.

2. TERMS OF REFERENCE

2.1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

2.1.1. SASSETA was established on 1 July 2005. It is one of the twenty-one Sector Education and Training Authorities (SETAs) established in terms of the Skills Development Act (Act 97 of 1998) as amended. SASSETA's license has been renewed until 31st March 2030. SASSETA is classified as a schedule 3A Public Entity in terms of the Public Finance Management Act, (Act 1 of 1999, as amended). SASSETA reports to the Department of Higher Education and Training.

2.2. PURPOSE

2.2.1. SASSETA requires a suitable and experienced service provider to supply and deliver 516 tablets.

2.3. SCOPE OF WORK AND DELIVERABLES REQUIRED

2.3.1. The service provider will be required to supply and deliver the following items:

2.4. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

2.4.1. Bidders to submit a minimum of two (2) reference letters on clients' letterhead with contactable references (existing or previous) where similar assignments/ contracts e.g., delivery of ICT equipment/peripherals) were undertaken. NB: Two (2) or more reference letters that indicate the entity's ability to deliver on similar assignments/ contracts e.g., delivery of ICT equipment/peripherals) will score maximum points.

2.5. TIMEFRAMES FOR DELIVERY OF THE WORK

- 2.5.1. The successful service providers will be required to deliver the above-mentioned items to a location in Gauteng (Tshwane) within a period of thirty (30) working days from the date of appointment.
- 2.5.2. The service provider is required to complete and submit confirmation of the ability to deliver all 516 tablets to the location in Gauteng (Tshwane) within a period of thirty (30) working days from date of appointment (bullet 3.2.1.2).

2.6. INSURANCE OF THE ITEMS BEFORE DELIVERY

2.6.1. The service provider is required to insure all ordered items until delivery to a location in Tshwane.

2.7. PRICING

2.7.1. Service Providers are requested to provide an all-inclusive price of this project assignment as listed on SBD 3.1

2.8. ACCOUNTABILITY AND REPORTING

2.8.1. The service provider will report directly to the Grants & Project Management Manager for the duration of the assignment.

2.9. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

2.9.1. The service provider will be contracting with SASSETA. All data of this project, in whatever format raw or analysed, will be the confidential information for utilisation by SASSETA. All information and documents received from SASSETA is to be kept confidential and may not be used or distributed in any format without the written approval of SASSETA. To this end, the service provider will be required to sign a confidentiality agreement within the SLA.

2.10. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION ACT
