



DISCRETIONARY GRANTS CLOSED FUNDING WINDOW 2019/2020 FINANCIAL YEAR

The Safety and Security Sector Education and Training Authority (SASSETA) invites employers to apply for discretionary grants for the following learning programme types. CBO's NGO's Cooperatives and registered Trade Unions operating in the Safety and Security sector are also invited to apply:

Unemployed Learnership Grants	Up to 800
Employed Skills Programmes Grants	Up to 700
Unemployed Skills Programmes Grants	Up to 300
Internships	Up to 70
TVET Placement Grants	Up to 300

Programmes applied for must meet the following criteria:

1. Employers must use duly accredited training providers, with registered assessors and moderators (not applicable to Internships and TVET Placements).
2. Must address the Critical & Scarce Skills identified in SASSETA's Sector Skills Plan published in August 2018 or the National List of Occupations in High Demand: 2018
3. If approved, training must **commence no later than 15 March 2020**
4. Employers who have self-funded learners **who commenced training anytime from 01 April 2019 to date** are also invited to apply.

Eligibility Criteria for NGO's, CBO's, Cooperatives and Trade Unions

1. Must be duly registered
2. Must be operating in the Safety and Security sector
3. Must have valid tax exemption / Tax Clearance / One-Time PIN

Application Instructions:

1. It is compulsory that all applicants comply with the new SASSETA Discretionary Grant Policy Version 8 when applying.
2. Applications must be placed in an envelope and marked **DG CLOSED FUNDING WINDOW 2019/2020**
3. The certified stamp on copies must not be older than **SIX** months.
4. All applications to be supported by the following documents (unless the applicant has an existing discretionary project with SASSETA and the updated documents are already in SASSETA's possession):
 - a) Company registration documents
 - b) Valid PSIRA registration (for private security sector) or Legal Practices Council registration (for legal sector) or other relevant Professional Body Registration documents for **BOTH** Employer and preferred training provider, where applicable
 - c) Valid COID Certificate or relevant insurance on public liability for **BOTH** Employer and preferred training provider. Should the Employer's COID cover learners while in training, the provider's COID will not be necessary.
 - d) Valid original Tax Clearance Certificate or SARS Tax Exemption certificate /Certificate of Good Standing issued by SARS with one time pin for sector employers or SARS Tax Exemption

All applications must reach SASSETA on or before 05 March 2020 at 14:00. Late applications will not be considered.


