As per mandate of the Quality Council for Trades and Occupations (QCTO) in terms of the NQF Act (Act No.67 of 2008) and Skills Development Act, 1998 (Act no 97 of 1998 as amended). SASSETA continues to implement its delegated functions.


The SASSETA ETQA is reminding Skills Development Providers (SDPs) on the implementation of final Integrated Summative Assessment (FISA) as we are striving towards the implementation of Quality Assurance function for the implementation of registered historical qualifications on the Occupational Qualifications Sub-Framework (OQSF).

Final Integrated Summative Assessment (FISA) for all historically registered **full qualifications** must be implemented as soon as possible in conjunction with the current Portfolio of Evidence (PoE) practice.

Skills Development Providers can continue to request external moderation (QALA/Verification) from SASSETA, as the current process SASSETA will ensure that a Final Integrated Summative Assessment (FISA) has been implemented by the Skills Development Providers (SDP) for assessment of each learner prior to the external moderation or verification taking place.
